WHEREAS, The Commemorative Air Force and the Boy Scouts of America desire to establish and maintain a collaborative relationship on behalf of young adults and families, we now enter into this agreement for the purpose of confirming a framework for a cooperative relationship under which the Units of the Commemorative Air Force and the Venturing Program of the Boy Scouts of America will assist one another in areas of mutual objectives, and

WHEREAS, "It is the mission of the Boy Scouts of America to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law," and

WHEREAS, The Venturing Program of Boy Scouts of America is desirous of lending its aid and support to the citizenship, character development, and personal fitness of young men and women through community based organizations, and


WHEREAS, one of the purposes of the Commemorative Air Force is to encourage the education of youth in the subject of American military and aviation history.


WHEREAS, the Commemorative Air Force is dedicated to continuing its mission to honor American military aviation in the future and to increase the awareness in American youth of the sacrifice of the men and women who worked to provide our continued freedom, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Commemorative Air Force and the Boy Scouts of America will work with each other within the rules and regulations of the Boy Scouts of America to establish and nurture Venturing Crews as an expression of the mission of the Commemorative Air Force and to educate youth in the history of American Military Aviation, so that they might be better aware of our country's history and continue on a path that will honor American military aviation and American military service men and women.

All public communications and/or announcements about this Agreement, including websites of the parties and their respective affiliates, licensees, and vendors will be mutually approved by both Boy Scouts of America and the Commemorative Air Force before they are issued.
